BHP is currently searching for an experienced individual to serve as a full time (40 hours) Crisis Intervention Specialist. This position is responsible for conducting psychosocial assessments including mental status examination, lethality examination and diagnosis. Candidates must have the ability to quickly engage, assess, problem solve, and reach crisis stabilization. The ability to maintain accurate and timely documentation of client services is essential. All positions in the department require flexibility in scheduling and work location. This position will serve both Licking and Knox Counties and will primarily second shift. In addition, this position will be responsible for shifts on Saturday and Sunday. The weekly 40-hour schedule for this position may include day and overnight shifts on Saturday and/or Sunday as well as intermittent on-call responsibilities in Knox and/or Licking Counties. Candidates should be advised that the 40-hour schedule will not always occur across five consecutive days. The Crisis Specialist may be required to cover additional shifts in rotation with other crisis workers as needed, including weekends, in both Knox and Licking counties. Requirements include: Bachelor's degree, prefer Masters with LSW/LPC; prefer LISW/LPCC; 1 year prior crisis experience preferred, Ohio Driver's License and transportation required. Basic computer and typing skills are required.
